SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RULES

Our scholarships are awarded to Oregon graduating high school seniors **who are also children or grandchildren of Oregon Collection Association's members, affiliate members & out of state member agency owners, managers, employees or agency clients.** The award is for Oregon High School seniors for their use as full time students at any Oregon accredited public, private college, university or trade school. Scholarship recipients must start attendance within 12 months of the award and show proof of enrollment for a minimum of 12 credit hours.

Essay subject is to be 1,000 to 1,500 words: Subject "Credit In The 21st Century".

Entries must be typed and able to be read in three to five minutes.

Each entry must include the applicant's full name, address, telephone numbers, email address, full name of his/her parents: the name of his/her high school with phone number, **and the name of the associated agency. If the child or grandchild of a client of an agency client, must have the name of the client. (Used for notification purposes only.)** **This information is to be on a separate cover sheet.**

Entry deadline is March 1, **2019** and must be postmarked by that date.
